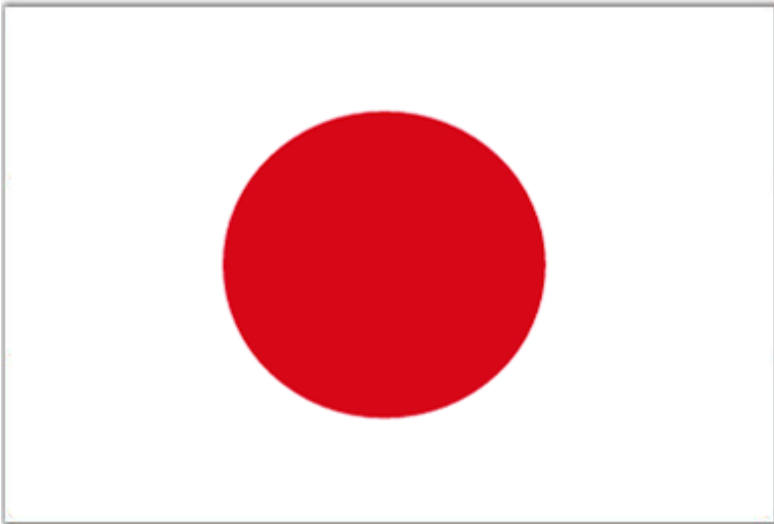


Japan earthquake: so many reasons to mourn, pray and think
